



Modern Slavery Act 2015

Galloper Wind Farm Holding Company Limited and Galloper Wind Farm Limited Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement 2020

Gallop er Wind Farm Limited and its holding company Gallop er Wind Farm Holding Company Limited (“the Companies”) owns Gallop er offshore wind farm, a 353MW offshore wind farm located 30km off the coast of Suffolk.

Gallop er Wind Farm Limited and Gallop er Wind Farm Holding Company Limited are committed to both the statutory requirements under the Modern Slavery Act 2015, and to acting with integrity in all business dealings and relationships to have a zero-tolerance approach to Modern Slavery. This is a position which they expect all of their suppliers to respect and adopt.

Gallop er Wind Farm Limited and Gallop er Wind Farm Holding Company Limited have appointed RWE Renewables UK Swindon Limited to provide services to it under a Management Services Agreement. Gallop er Wind Farm Limited and Gallop er Wind Farm Holding Company Limited have instructed RWE Renewables Swindon UK Limited, to

- (i) implement and enforce effective systems of controls to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place anywhere within its own business or in any of its own supply chains; and
- (ii) ensure that where it negotiates contracts with third parties in its name and on its behalf that such contracts provide suitable provisions relating to the systems of control that such third parties are taking to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place within their business and supply chains.
